### Mike Shellman's thoughts:

As we continue efforts to set this committee to work, it seems to me we need at least broad guidelines to frame our efforts. I propose establishment of "Guiding Principles" and have included three below for review and discussion. They are in no particular order of importance.

1. We will not move a flood problem. A solution is not viable if it relieves one property owner in the watershed by flooding another somewhere else.
2. Solutions will be measurable. This allows enhancement of what is working and analysis/correction of what is not.
3. Solutions will be revenue neutral to taxpayers. In the current economic climate any attempt to increase taxation will likely be met with fierce opposition.
